

Who are Fellow Laborers in The Gospel?

Christ followers who are compelled to follow Jesus' instructions to lead others into relationship with Him and initiate their journey of discipleship. They are pioneers of the great harvest work Jesus charged His disciples to focus on.

*He was saying to them, "The harvest is abundant [for there are many who need to hear the good news about salvation], but the workers [those available to proclaim the message of salvation] are few. Therefore, [prayerfully] ask the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest. **Luke 10:2** (Amplified)*

Who can be a FLITG?

Men and women who live a surrendered life to Christ, have an active relationship with Jesus and pray diligently for unbelievers. They possess a good understanding of salvation and water baptism and are willing to introduce new believers to the simple message of the Scriptures through discipleship.

*For we are laborers together with God: You are God's vineyard; you are God's building. **1 Corinthians 3:9** (Modern English Version)*

*I ask you also, true companion, help those women who labored with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and with my other fellow laborers, whose names are in the Book of Life. **Philippians 4:3** (Modern English Version)*

*Give my greetings to Prisca and Aquila, my fellow workers in Christ Jesus, ... **Romans 16:3** (Amplified)*

What is the heart of a FLITG:

- They are not concerned with any religious title, but only seek to serve Jesus' Great Commission. There is no concern for ministry degrees, credentials, or financial compensation, they simply desire to be a laborer with Christ.
- They are led by the Holy Spirit to utilize their education, career, business, and giftings to influence others with the message of Christ.
- They are men and women under Jesus' authority, demonstrating His love and compassion for the lost with the good news of salvation. It is their highest joy to lead others to Jesus.
- They are unafraid of the work of the harvest. They comprehend the value of the lives they introduce into the Kingdom of God. This is their reward.

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”
